#### 1. CHOOSE YOUR PROGRAM

#### 2. REVIEW YOUR REQUIREMENTS

#### 3. GET READY

Gather required information and documents, such as:

- · Names (including branch/campus) and addresses of colleges attended.
- List of exams, training, and certification programs you've completed.
- Have your official transcripts sent; directly to Excelsior from issuing institutions. Find out <u>where to send your</u> transcripts.

#### 4. SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA ONLINE

You can complete the Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) online at <u>fafsa.ed.gov</u>. This may help you obtain scholarships even if you don't plan to use financial aid now. The Excelsior College code for this application is **014251**.

#### 5. START YOUR APPLICATION

Do yourself a favor and begin filling out your application now. No need to wait—your information will be saved for you to finish later if you're interrupted.

If you don't already have a MyExcelsior account, you'll create one when you start the admissions process.
